

# Rotary Young Health Professionals Travel Award

## Award

[The Southern Division of Luleå Rotary Club](#) offers an award of a maximum of 15000 SEK for a young health professional from a low or middle income country, to cover travel, hotel and conference fee. The award will be handled by the conference organizing committee who will book the flights, hotel accommodation and conference fees on behalf of the awardee, i.e. it will not be paid out directly to the awardee.

## Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the award, the applicant should:

- Meet the age limit of 40 years.
- Have a well-documented interest in the field of psychosomatic medicine, consultation-liaison psychiatry or integrated care.
- Be a citizen and resident of a middle or low income country according to the [list of eligible countries](#).

## Application procedure

The applicant should send an email to the conference organizer [ursula.werneke@nll.se](mailto:ursula.werneke@nll.se) with the following content:

- A cover letter from the candidate outlining his/her interest in the competition including a statement of no more than 300 words why s/he should be considered for this award. The statement can refer to training, clinical practice and/or research in the field.
- A brief curriculum vitae (no more than one page, including date of birth).
- A declaration that the candidate, if selected for the award, will bear any costs in excess of SEK15000 him/herself.
- Eligible applications will be reviewed by an awards committee and decision about the award will be made by this committee in collaboration with the Executive Board of the EAPM.

The award can only be confirmed, if all costs as outlined above can be covered by the award or if the travel costs exceed the amount of SEK 15000, the awardee can provide written proof of additional funding within 14 days of notification.
